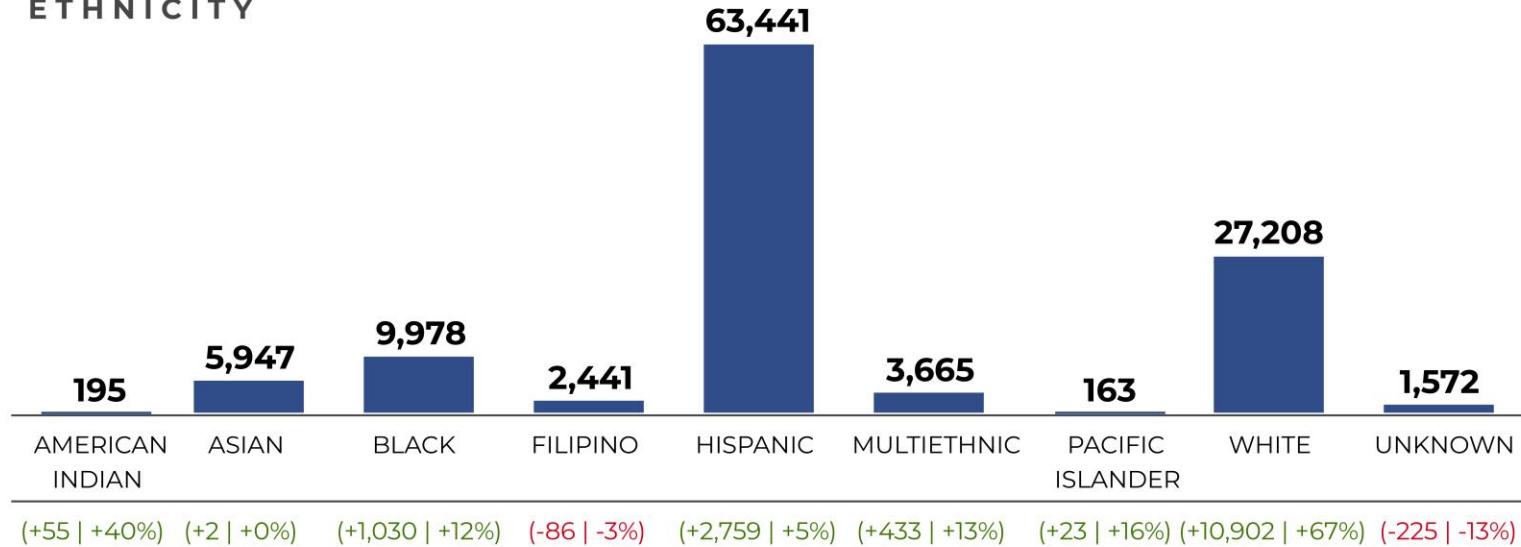

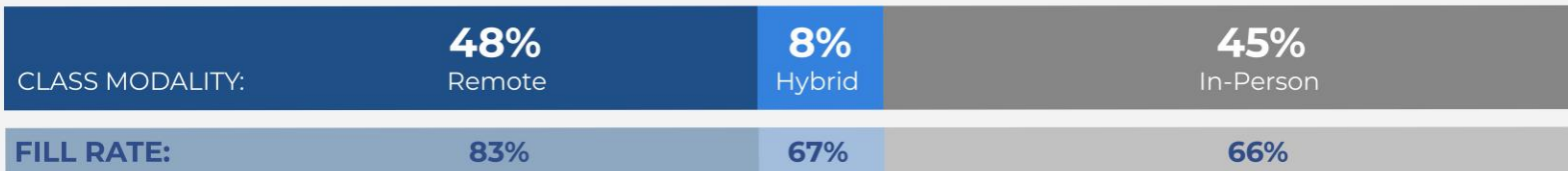
# Enrollment Update – Spring 2024



## ETHNICITY

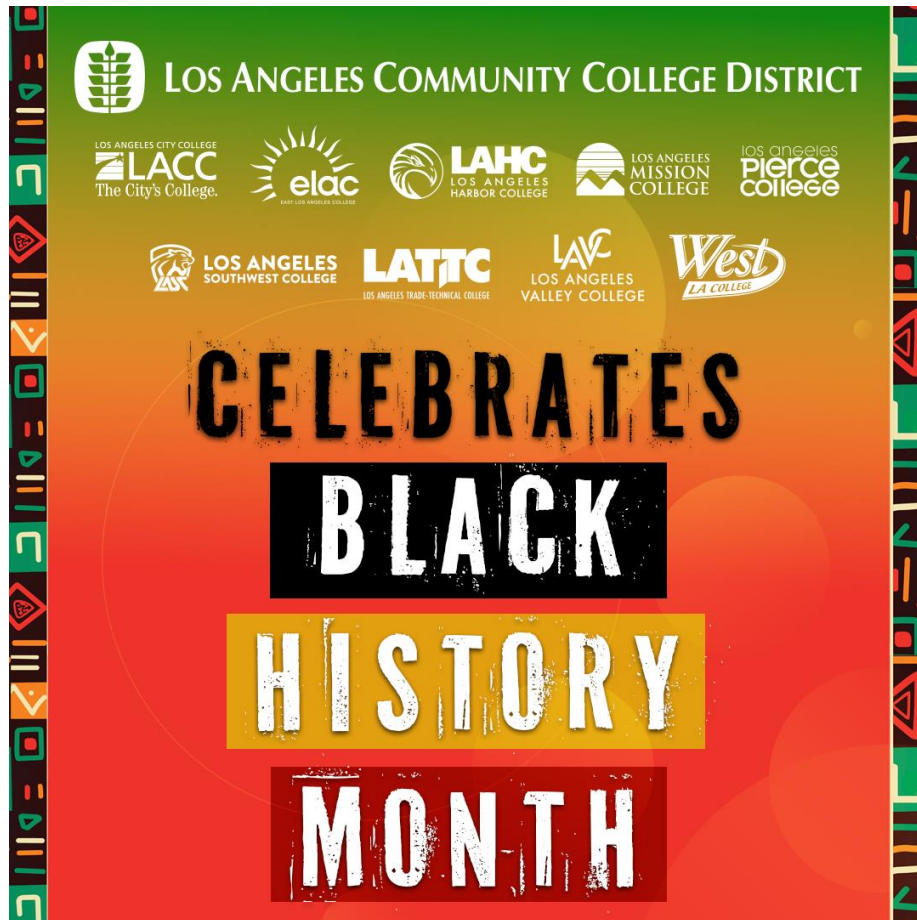


## CLASS MODALITY & FILL RATE
